On August 26th, Storm Ida was created. This flash flood has killed approximately 44 people in the Northeastern U.S states including New York, Pennsylvania, Connecticut and New Jersey. Transportation, such as subways and railways, suffered immensely. Around 370 flights were cancelled due to rain and severe winds. 170,000 people were left without electricity.
